The employee Overseas and the employee who will have to go on his return, are both single men and have no dependents.

It should be noted in passing that the work of the Social Welfare Commission is slightly different from that of other Civic Departments. Out of a staff of eighteen, only five are men, the rest being women. This is due largely to the impossibility of getting the right type of men at the salary the Commission are prepared to pay. The commencing salary of an Agent being from \$60.00 to \$65.00 according to their previous experience.

In accordance with your request, I beg to submit the following report on the number of men who enlisted for service with the C.E.F. and also statement of the men engaged since the war started.

You will notice that amongst the men returned, there are several who are either turnkeys or Asst. Turnkeys. When they left for Overseas this Department had four single horse turnkey rigs 2 men per rig, and two emergent rigs 2 men per rig, since that time we have dispensed with the horse rigs and now use two motor trucks for turnkeys engaging 4 men, and one truck for day and night emergency work engaging 4 men, the positions originally held by four of these men have been done away with, I will however place them in other work in the Department. In this regard quite a lot of work which had been done prior to the war has since 1914 been dispensed with.

By re-engaging in this work which is all of a necessary nature I can take care of the men as they return, discharging those who have been engaged since the war started with the exception of Mr. Brown who was transferred to this Dept. from the City Engineer's Dept.
